Access to Information

ACES employees who may access your information in order to perform pledge processing and administrative functions are prohibited from disclosing your information to third parties.

Names printed in ACES recognition materials are a matter of public record. If you do not want your name to appear, please indicate your gift should be recognized as "Anonymous".

Organizations that provide operational or other support services to ACES must also agree to safeguard your information in strict compliance with our privacy policy.

Firewalls prevent outside parties from accessing our database and internal ACES access to the database is restricted to authorized individuals.
